DGCA A320 TYPE RATING SYLLABUS

Training Stage	Description	Duration
MCC & JIT	Classroom	12 hrs
Airbus Procedure Training (APT)	On FNPT II	5 sessions (10 hrs as PF + 10 hours as PM)
Ground Training	Classroom with written exam	72 hrs
Full Flight Simulator	On Level D FFS	8 sessions (16 hrs as PF + 16 hrs as PM)
Line-Oriented Flight Training (LOFT)	On Level D FFS	1 session (2 hrs as PF + 2 hrs as PM)
Skill Test	CA40 Day & Night CA40 A (IR/PPC) on Level D FFS by DGCA Examiner	2 sessions (2 hrs each)

Total duration: approximately 40-50 days.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS TYPE RATING

To ensure that every trainee derives maximum value from the A320 Type Rating Programme, candidates must meet the following eligibility criteria as prescribed under DGCA guidelines:

- **License** – Valid Commercial Pilot License or ATPL.
- **Ratings** – Valid Multi-Engine (ME) and Instrument Rating (IR).
- **Flight Experience** – Minimum of 25 hours of multi-engine flight time, of which up to 10 hours may be completed on an approved simulator.
- **English Language Proficiency** – ICAO Level 4 or higher.
- **Medical Fitness** – Valid Class 1 Medical Certificate.
